

One Man Was Thankful

Luke 17:11–19 NASB

Characters:

Narrator

Jesus

10 Men

(Jesus enters stage – walking around)

Narrator: While Jesus was on the way to Jerusalem, He was passing between Samaria and Galilee.

(10 men enter a little distance from Jesus)

Narrator: As He entered a village, ten leprous men who stood at a distance met Him; and they raised their voices, saying,

Men: Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!

Jesus: Go and show yourselves to the priests.

Narrator: And as they were going, they were cleansed.

(Men look at themselves, surprised and overjoyed. 9 of the men run off, while one man stops and goes back to kneel in front of Jesus.)

Narrator: Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice, and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. And he was a Samaritan.

Jesus: Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine—where are they? Was no one found who returned to give glory to God, except this foreigner? Stand up and go; your faith has made you well.

(Man gets up excited and runs off)
