## Lookeba-Sickles Board of Education February 19, 2018 7:00 p.m. Board Room

The Lookeba-Sickles Board of Education met in regular session to conduct business for the month of February.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mr. House. Members present were Tommy House, Casey Horn, Jami Radacy, and Frank Klassen. Also in attendance were Mike Davis, Shirley Gathers, and Shana Lierle. Chad Cooper was absent. At this time Mr. Davis gave the invocation.

Mr. Horn made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, which included 2017-18 General Fund encumbrances #136 thru #139 and #50042. 2017-2018 General Fund warrants #620 thru #703. 2017-2018 Building Fund encumbrance #25. 2017-2018 Building Fund warrants #55 thru #63. 2017-2018 Child Nutrition Fund warrants #52 thru #56, that were reviewed and discussed. Mr. Klassen seconded this motion. Voting yes, Mrs. Radacy, Mr. Horn, Mr. House, and Mr. Klassen. Motion Passed

The re-organization of the school board was discussed at this time. The board voted to remain the same on a motion by Mrs. Radacy, seconded by Mr. Klassen, (1) President – Tommy House, (2) Vice-President – Jami Radacy, (3) Clerk – Frank Klassen, (4) Deputy Clerk – Chad Cooper, and (5) Legislative Network Member – Casey Horn. Voting yes, Mr. House, Mrs. Radacy, Mr. Horn, and Mr. Klassen. Motion Approved

At this time, Mrs. Gathers and Mr. Davis presented their principal's reports.

### Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Davis informed the board of upcoming school events, of individual member accumulated training points, and reminded the board of the upcoming Region 10 meeting that will be held at Redlands Community College.

At this time the board discussed independent auditors for the 2017-2018 school year. Mrs. Radacy made a motion to approve Angel, Johnston, and Blasingame as school auditors for the 2017-2018 school year. Mr. Horn seconded this motion. 
March 19, 2018, 7:00 p.m., was confirmed as the next regular school board meeting.


**New Business:**


