





Cable Hat Pattern

Abbreviations: K – Knit; P – purl; m1 – make a stitch (I prefer to do this by picking up the yarn from the previous row and knitting into the back of it); C6B – slip 3 stitches onto cable needle and place at back of work, knit next 3 stitches, knit 3 stitches on cable needle; K2tog – knit 2 stitches together.

Using 6.0mm circular needles or dpns cast on 72 stitches. Join in the round.

Rib pattern

Round 1. [K2, p2] to end of round.

Rounds 2 -9. Repeat round 1.

Round 10. [K2, p2, m1] to end of round (90 stitches).

Cable Pattern

Round 1. [K1, p1, K6, p1] to end of round

Rounds 2 and 3. Repeat round 1.

Round 4. [K1, p1, C6B, p1] to end of round.

Rounds 5-8. Repeat round 1.

Repeat cable pattern another 3 times.

Decreasing Rounds

[K2tog]to end of round (45 stitches).

K to end of round.

[K2tog] to last stitch of round, K1 (23 stitches).

[K2tog] to last stitch of round, K1 (12 stitches).

Cut yarn leaving a long length, using a blunt-tipped needle pull the yarn through the remaining 12 stitches, tighten and fasten well.
