KINGDOM = DISRUPTION IS AT HAND – MT. 11-12

Jesus did not come to comfort us but to discomfort us – to move us from sin to freedom, from darkness to light.

Acts 26:17-18 – “I am sending you (Paul) to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from dominion of Satan to God in order that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in me.”



DISRUPTION AS A FORCE FOR GOOD.

4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US.

1. He disrupts us personally. Mt. 11:3
2. He disrupts us corporately. Mt. 11:20-24
3. He disrupts us intellectually. Mt. 12:1-37
4. He disrupts us relationally. Mt. 12:46-50



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

1. Jesus disrupts John the Baptism. (Disrupts us personally)

Mt. 11:2-3 ²Now when John, while imprisoned, heard of the works of Christ, he sent *word* by his disciples ³and said to Him, “Are you the Expected One, or shall we look for someone else?”

Like JTB, we will ask: “God, is that you?”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

2. Jesus disrupts cities. (Disrupts us corporately)

Mt. 11:20-23 ²⁰ Then He began to denounce the cities in which most of His miracles were done, because they did not repent. ²¹ “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles had occurred in Tyre and Sidon which occurred in you, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. ²² Nevertheless I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in *the* day of judgment than for you. ²³ And you, Capernaum, will not be exalted to heaven, will you? You will descend to Hades; for if the miracles had occurred in Sodom which occurred in you, it would have remained to this day.



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

3. Jesus dismantles false teaching. (Disrupts us intellectually)

Mt. 12:1-2 ¹At that time Jesus went through the grain fields on the Sabbath, and His disciples became hungry and began to pick the heads *of grain* and eat. ² But when the Pharisees saw *this*, they said to Him, “Look, Your disciples do what is not lawful to do on a Sabbath.”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

3. Jesus dismantles false teaching. (Disrupts us intellectually)

Jesus scripture-shames the Pharisees:

Mt. 12:6-8 ⁶ But I say to you that something greater than the temple is here. ⁷ But if you had known what this means, 'I DESIRE COMPASSION, AND NOT A SACRIFICE,' you would not have condemned the innocent. ⁸ For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

3. Jesus dismantles false teaching. (Disrupts us intellectually)

Mt. 12:12-13 ¹² It is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.” ¹³ Then He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand!”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

3. Jesus dismantles false teaching. (Disrupts us intellectually)

Mt. 12:14 “The Pharisees went out and conspired against Him, as to how they might destroy Him.”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

3. Jesus dismantles false teaching.

(Disrupts us intellectually)

Mt. 12:22-24 ²² Then a demon-possessed man *who was* blind and mute was brought to Jesus, and He healed him, so that the mute man spoke and saw. ²³ All the crowds were amazed, and were saying, “This man cannot be the Son of David, can he?” ²⁴ But when the Pharisees heard this, they said, “This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons.”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

3. Jesus dismantles false teaching. (Disrupts us intellectually)

Mt. 12:31 “Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven.”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

4. Jesus disrupts how we think about family. (Disrupts us relationally)

Mt. 12:46-50 ⁴⁶ While He was still speaking to the crowds, behold, His mother and brothers were standing outside, seeking to speak to Him.⁴⁷ Someone said to Him, “Behold, Your mother and Your brothers are standing outside seeking to speak to You.” ⁴⁸ But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, “Who is My mother and who are My brothers?” ⁴⁹ And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, “Behold My mother and My brothers! ⁵⁰ For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother.”



4 WAYS JESUS DISRUPTS US

4. Jesus disrupts how we think about family. (Disrupts us relationally)

1 Cor. 7:29 “From now on, those who have wives should be as though they had none.”
