Josh. 3:1-5 When Joshua rose early in the morning; and he and all the sons of Israel set out from Shittim and came to the Jordan, and they lodged there before they crossed. <sup>2</sup> At the end of three days the officers went through the midst of the camp; <sup>3</sup> and they commanded the people, saying, "When you see the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God with the Levitical priests carrying it, then you shall set out from your place and go after it. <sup>4</sup> However, there shall be between you and it a distance of about 2,000 cubits by measure. Do not come near it, that you may know the way by which you shall go, for you have not passed this way before." <sup>5</sup> Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you."

# **God Chose Israel to Possess the Ark**


# **Deuteronomy 14:2**

1. Priests go first.

Josh. 3:6 And Joshua spoke to the priests, saying, "Take up the ark of the covenant and cross over ahead of the people." So they took up the ark of the covenant and went ahead of the people.

2. Stand in the water.

Josh. 3:8 You shall, moreover, command the priests who are carrying the ark of the covenant, saying, 'When you come to the edge of the waters of the Jordan, you shall stand still in the Jordan.

3. Move Your Tents.

Josh. 3:14 So...the people set out from their tents to cross the Jordan with the priests carrying the ark of the covenant before the people.

4. Act quickly.

Josh. 4:10 For the priests who carried the ark were standing in the middle of the Jordan until everything was completed that the Lord had commanded Joshua to speak to the people, according to all that Moses had commanded Joshua. And the people hurried and crossed.

# 5. Remember the Goodness of God.

**Josh. 4:3,20-22** <sup>3</sup>...command them (leaders from each of the 12) tribes), saying, 'Take up for yourselves twelve stones from here out of the middle of the Jordan, from the place where the priests' feet are standing firm, and carry them over with you and lay them down in the lodging place where you will lodge tonight.' ...<sup>20</sup> Those twelve stones which they had taken from the Jordan, Joshua set up at Gilgal. <sup>21</sup> He said to the sons of Israel, "When your children ask their fathers in time to come, saying, 'What are these stones?' 22 then you shall inform your children, saying, 'Israel crossed this Jordan on dry ground.' 23 For the LORD your God dried up the waters of the Jordan before you until you had crossed, just as the LORD your God had done to the Red Sea, which He dried up before us until we had crossed.

# THE WHOLE FAMILY LABORS TOGETHER

Josh. 4:12 The sons of Reuben and the sons of Gad and the half-tribe of Manasseh crossed over in battle array before the sons of Israel, just as Moses had spoken to them; <sup>13</sup> about 40,000 equipped for war, crossed for battle before the Lord to the desert plains of Jericho.
