1. PARABLE OF SOWER (13:3) - addresses our strength as workers.

2. PARABLE OF WHEAT & TARES (13:24) – speaks to our competition.



Mt. 13:38 The field is the world, and the good seed stands for the people of the kingdom. The weeds are the people of the evil one, ³⁹ and the enemy who sows them is the devil.

3. PARABLE OF MUSTARD SEED (13:31) – is about our potential.



Mt. 13:31-32 ³¹ He told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field. ³² Though it is the smallest of all seeds, yet when it grows, it is the largest of garden plants and becomes a tree, so that the birds come and perch in its branches."

4. PARABLE OF YEAST (13:33) – relates to our calling.



Mt. 13:33 He told them still another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into about sixty pounds of flour until it worked all through the dough.

5. PARABLE OF HIDDEN TREASURE (13:44) – explains our happiness power. We have the joy of the Lord.



Mt. 13:44 "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field."

6. PARABLE OF PEARL (13:45) – speaks to the value proposition of the kingdom in business terms.



Mt. 13:45-46 ⁴⁵ "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. ⁴⁶ When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it.

7. PARABLE OF NET (13:47) – illustrates the seriousness of our work.



Mt. 13:47-50 47 "Once again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was let down into the lake and caught all kinds of fish. ⁴⁸ When it was full, the fishermen it up on the shore. Then they sat down and collected the good fish in baskets, but threw the bad away. 49 This is how it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous 50 and throw them into the blazing furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
