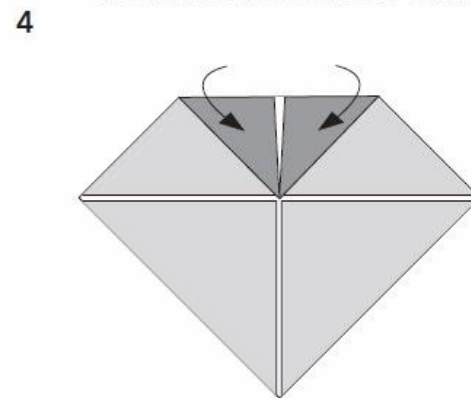
1. with pictures face down, fold on both diagonals, Unfold



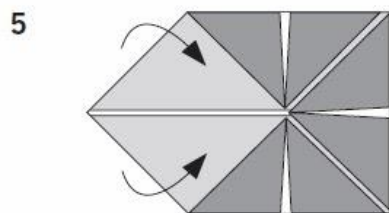
2. Fold all four corners to centre



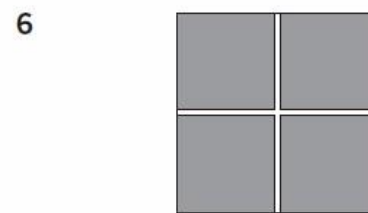
3. Now, your paper should be like this.



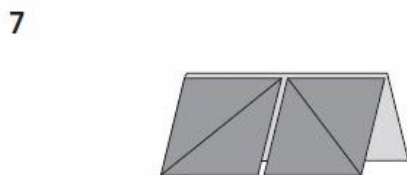
4. Flip the paper over and once again
Fold the tips to meet the centre point.



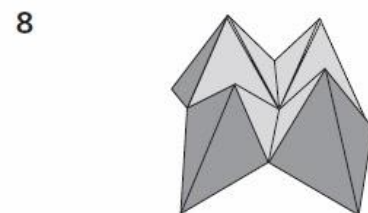
5. Now, your piece of paper should look like this.
