Enhanced Landfill Mining Seminar
20-10-2015**Registration now open for ELFM Seminar in European Parliament**

On **20 October 2015** (15.30-18.30) the European Parliament hosts a milestone Enhanced Landfill Mining Seminar. The event is organised by two Members of the European Parliament (**Hilde VAUTMANS & Mark DEMESMAEKER**), in active collaboration with the European Enhanced Landfill Mining Consortium (**EURELCO**).

The Seminar will have attention for both **USW/Urban Solid Waste** and **metal-rich, industrial process residue landfills**. Leading EURELCO actors will present the state-of-the-art for ELFM with respect to both USW and industrial landfills. The keynote lectures will be followed by two panel discussions where key actors from both the European Commission (incl. DG GROW and DG RTD) and representatives from industry, academia and public bodies will discuss the technical, economic, environmental and legal aspects of ELFM in Europe.
