## **JOB OPENINGS**

Professional Research Assistant for **Tribal Turning Point**

Location: **Shiprock, NM**

The Colorado School of Public Health, Lifecourse Epidemiology of Adiposity and Diabetes (LEAD) Center has three openings for Professional Research Assistants (PRA)— one position at 1.0 FTE (40 hours/week), another position at 0.8 FTE (32 hours/week), and a part-time position at 0.2 FTE (5-10 hrs/wk). **The work location will be Shiprock, New Mexico.**

These positions will support the randomized controlled trial (RCT), Tribal Turning Point (TTP). TTP is a five-year, multi-site RCT study funded by the National Institute of Health that will rigorously evaluate the effect of TTP, a newly developed behavioral intervention for American Indian (AI) child-parent dyads, on diabetes risk factors in 300 children who are overweight or obese, 7-10 years of age, and living in urban (Phoenix, AZ) or rural (Shiprock, NM and Chinle, AZ) communities served by the Indian Health Service.
