

# Pumpkin



crochet pattern by Crochettiky





## 1. Instruments and materials

- orange and green cotton yarn 4ply;
- hook suitable for your yarn;
- fiberfill;
- scissors;
- sewing needle.

## 2. Abbreviations

- **AR** – amigurumi ring
- **SC** – single crochet
- **INC** – increase (2 single crochet in one loop)
- **DEC** – invisible decrease (1 single crochet in 2 loops)

### TIP:

The toy should be crocheted with tight stitches to be sure that they will keep a right form. Carefully choose the hook for your yarn. The size of the final creations will be also depend on chosen yarn and hooks.



### 3. Pumpkin

**1 row:** 6SC in AR (6)

**2 row:** 6INC (12)

*Rows 3-18 crochet in the back loops only.*

**3 row:** (1INC, 1SC) repeat 6 times (18)

**4 row:** 1SC, (1INC, 2SC) repeat 5 times, 1INC, 1SC (24)

**5 row:** (1INC, 3SC) repeat 6 times (30)

**6 row:** 2SC, (1INC, 4SC) repeat 5 times, 1INC, 2SC (36)

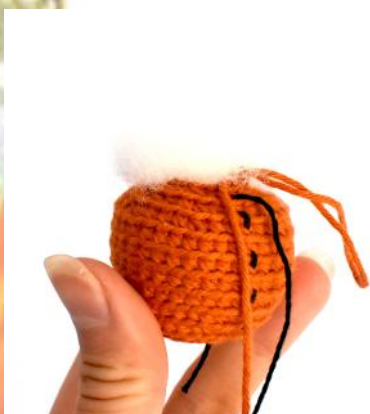
**7-15 rows:** 36SC (36)

**16 row:** 2SC, (1DEC 4SC) repeat 5 times, 1INC, 2SC (30)

**17 row:** (1DEC, 3SC) repeat 6 times (24)

**18 row:** 1SC, (1INC, 2SC) repeat 5 times, 1INC, 1SC (18)

*Fill the pumpkin with fiberfill. It should be quite soft.*

*Change the yarn for green color.*

*Rows 19-21 crochet in both loops.*

**19 row:** (1DEC, 1SC) repeat 6 times (12)

**20-21 row:** 6DEC (6)

*Cut the yarn. Close the hole using yarn tail.*

*Hide the tail inside the pumpkin.*

## 4. Figuration

Put the orange thread between green and orange part of the pumpkin. Form a future groove using crochet needle and free front loops (Pic. 6).

Pierce the pumpkin (Pic. 7) and strongly pull off (Pic. 8).

Repeat the first step to fix the groove (Pic. 9)

Pull off the pumpkin and fix the thread (Pic. 10).

Make 6-8 grooves to finish your pumpkin.
