White Wedding

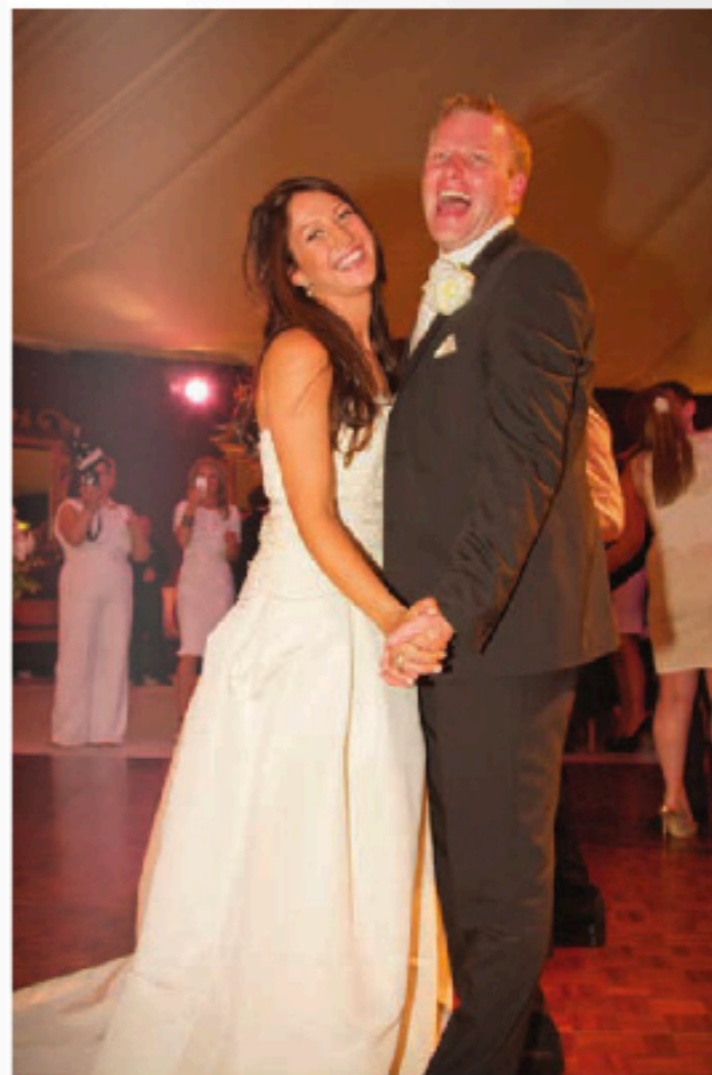
