I am attaching information with regards to a Diocesan scholarship grant that is available to new and returning families, "Sustaining Hope for the Future Scholarship." The purpose of this grant is to improve the ability of families to afford tuition for K – 8 students in our Catholic schools for the 2020 -2021 school year. The Mother Cabrini Health Foundation has made this scholarship available for the families in the Diocese of Ogdensburg. Families with household incomes that are no more than 20% above federal free and reduced lunch eligibility program income guidelines, or families who are experiencing challenging circumstances such as loss of income/job, illness, fixed incomes, unforeseen childcare expenses, etc. may apply for this scholarship.

I am attaching an application along with income guidelines. This application, verification of income, and/or a letter of extenuating circumstances will need to be returned to me by **August 15**, **2020**.
