**Re: Complaint into Torrey Pines High School Baseball Program Dated Jan 3, 2017**

Dear [REDACTED],

It is my understanding the above referenced complaint has characteristics that require that it follow uniform complaint procedures as is further described in district Policy 1312 et al.

To date, the following process events has transpired:

- January 3, 2017 – submitted the above referenced complaint to CIF San Diego Section Office (<http://www.cifsd.org/>). This complaint was submitted to CIF due to the nature of the complaint and a need to have it reviewed by an entity outside the School District.
- January 4, 2017 – It is my understanding that CIF personnel, Jerry Schniepp, Commissioner and John Labeta, Assistant Commissioner spoke with School District personnel and set up a meeting to meet in person with the School District on January 12, 2017. On this day (4<sup>th</sup>), John Labeta at CIF called and updated me and indicated there were roughly 7 or 8 violations noted in the detailed investigation request that fell within CIF's jurisdiction and that the District was contemplating hiring a third party investigator to look into the complaint as a whole.
- January 5, 2017 – I dropped off a full hard copy of the Investigation request to Superintendent Dill's office so he would have time to review prior to the meeting with CIF.
- January 12, 2017 – District and CIF meet

- January 19, 2017 - Attended the School Board Meeting. Upon completion of the school board meeting Mr. Dill informed me that an investigator would be contacting me with regards to the complaint.
- February 1, 2017 – Met with yourself and you explained you were hired as an independent third Party to investigate the complaint. You explained that this was a complicated complaint that would take some time to be done right. You also explained that you are an agent of the District as it pertains to the Complaint but were hired through the office of the School District's Legal Council.
- February 16, 2017 – submitted new information that there has been a leak in the School's process of keeping my identity confidential as the baseball coach expressed displeasure to my student of his mother's actions. And I continue to learn from others outside of Torrey Pines that the coaches are inciting derogatory and hateful speech against me to the Torrey Pines baseball players.

Given the nature of the complaint, it is in the best interest of all students that it is done correctly. However, it is also in all student's best interest that it is done expeditiously.

Given that the School District, has demonstrated with its actions that they have not kept this confidential as I had requested, I am hesitant to allow the investigation to drag on. With this said, I will grant an extension of an additional 60-days to complete the investigation.

I would also request in writing back from the District/or it's Agent acknowledgement from the district the events to date and will continue to proceed in good faith for the benefit of all students in the District. Also, if it is needed to complete the investigation correctly, I would request in writing from the District how much more time is needed.
