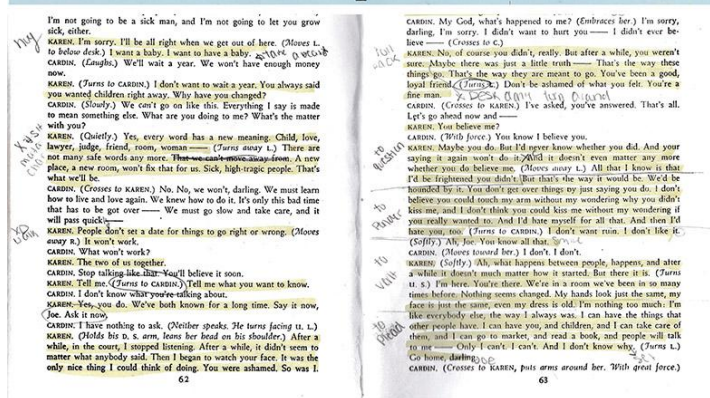
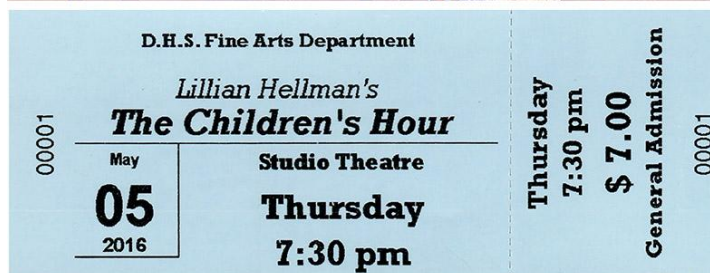
From Lori, her mom:
