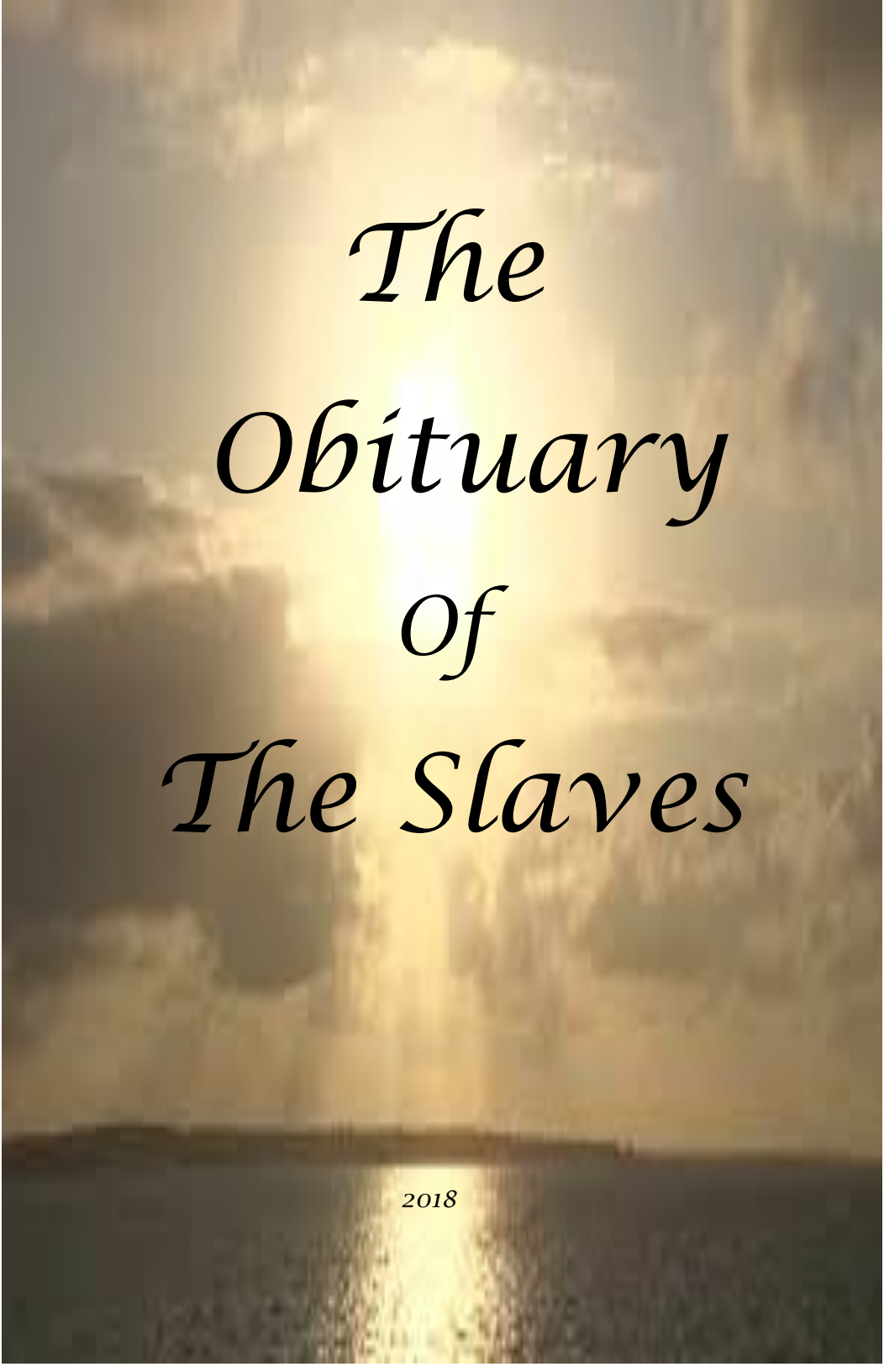

Exodus 3; 13

¹³ And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them?

¹⁴ And God said unto Moses, **I AM THAT I AM:** and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **I AM** hath sent me unto you.

¹⁵ And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, the LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: **this is my name for ever**, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

*Moses we know was a great, and faithful man of GOD called upon to teach the Children of Israel, GODS customs, regulations, their laws and rights; even setting them free from Egyptian bondage. All in honor of GOD, for "The Children of Israel". (See full Book of Exodus) Our focus is on the works in Deuteronomy. After completing his works and setting the Children of Israel free from Egyptian bondage, GOD granted Moses another honor; of bestowing upon the Children of Israel, The Commandments. (Deut. Ch. 5) He was also given the Honor and Dishonor of giving the decree of the Children of Israel's **Blessings & Curses**. Should they or Should they not choose to follow the commandments.

(See Deuteronomy for full understanding)

Deuteronomy 11

26 Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse;

27 A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day:

28 And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

***Understand that they did not listen, so I'm not going to discuss the Blessings as that is not what happened;**

Deuteronomy 9

¹² And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have corrupted themselves; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image. (A Calf v16)

¹³ Furthermore the LORD spake unto me, saying, **I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a stiff necked people:**

²⁴ Ye have been rebellious against the LORD from the day that I knew you

***It didn't stop there, from the breaking of the tablets, Deut 9,9; being led in the wilderness 40 years; deut 2;7, 8,2. These people just would not listen.**

***GOD told Moses who was getting old by then,**

Deuteronomy 31v 14:

Behold thy days approach that thou must die.

But before he died GOD told Moses what was going to happen.

Deuteronomy 31

16 And the LORD said unto Moses, Behold, thou shalt sleep with thy fathers;(DIE) and this people will rise up, and go a whoring after the gods of the strangers of the land, whither they go to be among them, and will forsake me, and break my covenant which I have made with them.

²⁴ And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished,

²⁷ For I know thy rebellion, and thy stiff neck: behold, while I am yet alive with you this day, ye have been rebellious against the LORD; and how much more after my death?

²⁹ For I know that after my death ye will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will

befall you in the latter days; because ye will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands

Deuteronomy c-29

²⁶ For they went and served other gods, and worshipped them, gods whom they knew not, and whom he had not given unto them:

²⁷ And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the CURSES that are written in this book:

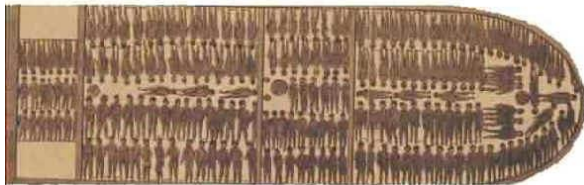
Isaiah 58 1 Cry aloud Spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet and show my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sin.

Deuteronomy: 28

⁴⁷ Because thou servedst not the LORD thy God with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things;

⁴⁹ The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

⁶⁸ And the LORD shall bring thee into Egypt again with ships, by the way whereof I spake unto thee, Thou shalt see it no more again: and there ye shall be sold unto your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen, and no man shall buy you.



*No one brought them, as they have never been paid for their service.

⁴¹ Thou shalt beget sons and daughters, but thou shalt not enjoy them; for they shall go into captivity

³² Thy sons and thy daughters shall be given unto another people, and thine eyes shall look, and fail with longing for them all the day long; and there shall be no might in thine hand.

48 Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the LORD shall send against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all things: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he has



destroyed thee.

⁵¹ And he shall eat the fruit of thy cattle, and the fruit of thy land, until thou be destroyed: which also shall not leave thee corn, wine, or oil, or the increase of thy kine, or flocks of thy sheep, until he have destroyed thee.

⁵⁹ Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, even great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance.

⁶¹ Also every sickness, and every plague, which is not written in the book of this law, them will the LORD bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed.

Isaiah 42



22: But this is a people robbed and spoiled; they are all of them snared (trapped) in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none say, Restore. (Repair, reparations)

There are many curses of these people, this is but a few.

*Understand that because these people, (our ancestors) did not want to Listen to the LORD, and because the LORD MUST do all he said he would do: but how could he? His children didn't want him! So he had to create a pure child, to go through hell, to get his brothers and sisters from an enemy they refused to leave. And when he went to get them:

They & ALL THE OTHER NATIONS of people-(EVERYBODY ON EARTH'S ANCESTORS): mocked the LORDS SON, and ultimately had something to do with him being KILLED or LOOTED & POLLUTED his treasures & HIS FATHERS WORDS: This is what really happened.

Let's Listen:

Matthew 1 v ²¹ And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

3 v ¹⁶ And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

¹⁷ And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Matthew 17v ²² And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men:

²³ And they shall kill him, and the third day he shall be raised again. And they were exceeding sorry.

Matthew 27v ¹ Early in the morning, all the chief priests and the elders of the people made their plans how to have Jesus executed. ² So they bound him, led him away and handed him over to Pilate the governor.

²² “What shall I do, then, with Jesus who is called the Messiah?” Pilate asked.

They all answered, “Crucify him!”

²⁵ All the people answered, “His blood is on US and on our Children!”

⁴⁵ From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land. ⁴⁶ About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, “Eli, Eli, ^[c] lema sabachthani?” (which means “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”). ^[d]

⁴⁸ Immediately one of them ran and got a sponge. He filled it with wine vinegar, put it on a staff, and offered it to Jesus to drink.

⁴⁹ The rest said, “Now leave him alone. Let’s see if Elijah comes to save him.”

⁵⁰ And when Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his

Spirit.

** I know that we have been taught that the LORDs son was hung on a cross; however the wooden cross is supposed to be a representation of the tree he was actually hung from.*

Acts 5

30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

ACTS 10

39 And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree:

ACTS CHP 13

29 And when they had fulfilled all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree, and laid him in a sepulcher.

**also 1peter c2 v 21&24 *This of course is not our Savior-(but you get the picture)*



The cross is suppose to “represent” the tree, but in times past this was also a way to worship the Roman god ESUS.

The Reason for GODs anger? Look at all that’s happened. Not to mention:

Ezekiel 29

26 For they went and served other GODs and worshipped them, and whom he had not given them.

27 And the Lords anger was kindled against this land to bring upon it all the curses written in this book.

28 And the Lord rooted them out of their land as it is this day.

Here are some of the Idols:

Exodus 20

3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me. 4Thou shalt not make unto thee ANY graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth



A:This is actually Zeus the Roman God, who was the “God of all Gods” as thought the Romans, who noted Roman scholars have said the Image of Jesus came from

ROMANS 11

29 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.

25Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed anything, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;
(Ref: Isaiah 44 v14-18)

Why is GOD so adamant about these thing?

Baring there was no J in biblical times, J was the **last** letter added to the English Alphabet- around **1600** –after slavery ,So leaving off the J you **have** ESUS the vegetation god, take away the E you **have** SUS which is **pig, hog, swine**

Romans 1

²² Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

²³ And CHANGED the glory of the uncorruptible GOD into an IMAGE made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four-footed beasts, and creeping things.



²⁵ Who changed the TRUTH of God into a LIE, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.

Haggai 1

15Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

*He said they go about land and sea to make one religion and make him **more like the child of hell**.

St John 4

23 But the hour cometh and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth

Isaiah 43

¹⁰Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.

¹²Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I AM he; I AM the First, I also am the Last.

¹⁶Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there am I: and now the Lord GOD, and his Spirit, hath sent me

Isaiah 48

3I have declared the former things from the beginning; and they went forth out of my mouth, and I shewed them; I did them suddenly, and they came to pass.

5I have even from the beginning declared it to thee; before it came to pass I shewed it thee: lest thou shouldest say, Mine idol hath done them, and my graven image, and my molten image, hath commanded them. .

6Thou hast heard, see all this; and will not ye declare it? I have shewed thee new things from this time, even hidden things, and thou didst not know them.

7They are created now, and not from the beginning; even before the day when thou heardest them not; lest thou shouldest say, Behold, I knew them.

8Yea, thou heardest not; yea, thou knewest not; yea, from that time, that thine ear was not opened: for I knew that thou wouldest deal very treacherously, and wast called a transgressor from the womb

Ezekiel 36

²² Therefore say unto the house of Israel, thus saith the Lord God; I do not this for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine Holy Name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went.

³¹ Then shall ye remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall lothe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and for your abominations.

³² Not for your sakes do I this, saith the Lord God, be it known unto you: be ashamed and confounded for your own ways, O house of Israel

Ezekiel 39

²¹ And I WILL set my glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them.

²² So the house of Israel shall know that I AM the LORD their God from that day and forward.

²³ And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they trespassed against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword.

²⁴ According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them.

²⁵ Therefore thus saith the Lord God; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for My Holy Name;

Ezekiel 20

³⁴ And I will bring you out from the people, and will gather you out of the countries wherein ye are scattered, with a mighty hand, and with a stretched out arm, and with fury poured out.

³⁵ And I will bring you into the wilderness of the people, and there will I plead with you face to face.

³⁶ Like as I pleaded with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so will I plead with you, saith the Lord God.

³⁷ And I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant:

³⁸ And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

***The Lord is pleading with us, like he did our forefathers**

Isaiah 40

1 Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God.

2 Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD's hand double for all her sins.

Isaiah 63

4 For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

Lamentations 4

²² The punishment of thine iniquity is accomplished, O daughter of Zion; he will no more carry thee away into captivity: he will visit thine iniquity, O daughter of Edom

Isaiah 43

9 Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, It is truth.

10 Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I AM he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.

¹² I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when there was no strange god among you: therefore ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, that:

I AM God.

¹³ Yea, before the day was I AM he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand:

I will work, and who shall let it?

Isaiah 33

13 Hear ye afar off what I have done; and ye that are near acknowledge My Might

Isaiah: 45

22 Look unto me and be ye saved all the ends of the earth for I am the LORD and beside me there is NONE ELSE

(*There is No one else to save you.)

23 I have sworn by MYSELF, the word is gone out of my mouth it will not return void.

(He said HE did it, by his word, BY HIMSELF)

Ezekiel 39

⁷ So I WILL make my HOLY NAME known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that

I AM

The Holy One in Israel.

Ephesians 6

¹²⁻¹⁴ And now having done all you could to Stand

¹⁰ Now will I RISE UP... saith the Lord;

²⁵ And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David shall be their prince for-ever.

²⁶ Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them; it shall be an everlasting covenant with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.

²⁷ My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

²⁸ And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.

There is no peace sayeth the LORD unto the wicked.

Nahum 1

² God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserveth wrath for his enemies.

³ The LORD is slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit the wicked: the LORD hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds are the dust of his feet

⁶ Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? His fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him

¹⁵ For the day of THE LORD is near upon all the heathen: as thou hast done, it shall be done unto thee: thy reward shall return upon thine own head

Romans 1

¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

¹⁹ Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.

²⁰ For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Jeremiah 42¹¹ Be not afraid of the king of Babylon, of whom ye are afraid; be not afraid of him, saith the Lord: for I am with you to save you, and to deliver you from his hand

* He said he only gave us over to satan for the whooping he knew we would get, a punishment and a redemption

⁵To deliver such a one to satan for the destruction of our flesh that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Savior...

⁸And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

²⁴ I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the Lord

³⁶ A sword is upon the liars; and they shall dote: a sword is upon her mighty men; and they shall be dismayed.

*He said punishment for some of the wicked will come so swiftly he's warning US not to be afraid.

¹⁵ And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, CHOOSE YOU this day whom YE will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell:

*He said does this seem wrong-(evil) to you to serve the MOST HIGH? He said choose for yourself who you will serve. This is The Most Important vote you could ever cast, and we ALL have one. The choice is YOURS

Isaiah 55
