PHILOSOPHY:

The Field Hockey BC Jenny John Officiating Professional Development Bursary is designed to contribute towards an individual's professional development in the sport of Field Hockey and is tailored to a value added 'give back' to field hockey in British Columbia. The Bursary is open to all levels of official, with officiating including both umpires and technical officials.

DESCRIPTION:

A bursary up to a maximum of \$750 will be awarded each year. However, if, in any one year, there are multiple candidates accepted, smaller amounts may be considered.

CRITERIA: The applicant must

- 1. Be member in Good Standing of Field Hockey BC
- 2. Be an active Official within National, Provincial, or Club based programming
