

Advent is a time of preparation! Our readings in worship this month call us to "Prepare the way of the Lord." We're urged to wait in expectation, alert and watchful as we await the arrival of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We commonly think of Advent as preparing for Christmas, for the birth of the baby Jesus. But how does one prepare and wait for an event that already happened 2,000 years in the past?

Our present waiting and longing is for Christ's coming in the future, his promised return in glory to judge the living and the dead, and establish his kingdom on earth forever. With all of creation, we eagerly await our restoration, the end of sin, death, and tears, and the joy of life in the New Jerusalem with God.

How do we prepare the way for this?



It's not too soon to start thinking about summer camp for your family in 2019!


You can view the 2019 summer schedule for Green Lake Lutheran Ministries at www.gllm.org or on the Narthex bulletin board. Stay tuned as we determine dates for "Zion Week" at GLLM in 2019. Online registration will open on December 3. Registrations received before February 15 will get \$40 off of each registered program.

The 2019 theme at GLLM will be "Transformed Community," focused on Romans 12:2, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect."

Community is a big part of what is fostered and strengthened while kids, youth, families, and congregations participate in all that camp has to offer. Sharing faith in a setting away from the distractions of everyday life, in God's beautiful creation, and with other people, is a wonderful thing! As God moves in our lives, communities of all kinds change and grow, and camp is no exception.

GLLM has also announced that a few of their programs have transformed, too. They've shared the following updates:

- The former "Chrysalis Crew" age group (5th-7th grade) will now attend camp at Shores of St. Andrew. This program will now be called "Trailblazers." We will offer unique programming for this group at Shores, so the program will continue to be great, just at a new location.
- Our core programs of Stargazers, Trailblazers,
 Andy's Gang and Half Blast continue to be offered throughout the summer.
- Again this summer, we are offering an updated
 Senior High program at GLBC for 9-12 graders
 who love to come to camp. This program will



include service opportunities, fun at the lake, a worship planning experience, faith conversations with local leaders, and other new experiences.

- In addition to our traditional favorites, look for Staff-In-Training at GLBC, North Shore Servant Adventures and a new Fishing Camp week at Camp House, and MAD Camp and Fishing Camp at Shores!
- Our Family Camp ministry will move from the Shores Village to the Chrysalis House at GLBC. We are excited to continue our great Family Camp offerings at a reduced cost. Family Camp will be open for a family max fee of \$710 at Tier 1. This is a significant decrease from past years. We are excited to offer new amenities, creative programming, and focused family ministry at GLBC!




Make this fun decoration as a reminder of the joy Jesus brings.



Caring Coins

Social Ministry wishes to thank all those who donated a total of \$263.59 for our November Caring Coins recipient, Partners for Affordable Housing (PAH), located on Good Counsel Hill in Mankato. PAH is the parent agency for Mankato's two homeless shelters and owns and operates several site housing facilities that provide different housing options, including transitional and permanent affordable housing to homeless and/or at risk individuals and families in the Mankato area. PAH houses a free store that provides a wide variety of household items. Thanks as well to those who donated any household items during November. Those will be delivered in early December.

December 9th will be Caring Coins Sunday when all gifts will benefit the Lake Crystal Ministerial Association. LCMA member churches include Abundant Life Christian, Cornerstone United Methodist, First Baptist, First Presbyterian, Holy Family Catholic, Our Savior's (Butternut) and Zion Lutheran. These funds are most commonly used to provide limited emergency support in the form of vouchers that can be used for gas or groceries. Vouchers are approved and distributed by pastors to travelers or community residents. This association also helps organize the summer VBS program and LCWM's Baccalaureate Service in May. Checks can be made to Zion, with Caring Coins or Ministerial Association written in the memo line. Thank you for your gifts!

In early November, Sandy Friday, Linda Isebrand and Joyce Roberts shopped for The REACH in Mankato. Thanks to your generous gifts and a Thrivent Action Team grant, we were able to purchase more than \$600 in supplies that were then delivered to the center for use by their clients.
