This route takes the rider along quiet country lanes to the west and south of Horsham with the exception of the first section on the busy Worthing Road to The Boar's Head public house. Much of the route is fairly flat except for a hilly section in West Chiltington/Ashington.

1. Start anywhere in Horsham. The Forum car park in Blackhorse Way is the most suitable car park. Turn left from the car park and straight over the Sainsbury's roundabout into the Worthing Road. Right at The Boar's Head pub (GR164296) passing under A24 to the T-junction just over the Downs Link bridge by the The Bax Castle pub.

2. Right along Two Mile Ash Road to Barns Green. Left at T-junction in Barns Green, past Queen's Head pub and right just before level crossing following sign to Coneyhurst.

3. Left, then right at Coneyhurst at junction with A272 to Broadford Bridge. Left at junction with B2133 and immediately right into Broadford Bridge road. Continue over crossroads at West Chiltington past church to T-junction.

4. Right into Southlands Lane. Past The Three Bells pub and into Roundabout Lane. Turn left and left again at junction and continue to T-junction with Storrington road.

5. Right then left into Merrywood Lane following sign to Ashington. Left and left again at junction. Continue towards Ashington turning right at Warminghurst Church at the top of a steep hill.

6. Left at T-junction in Ashington, by Ashington Automobile Company, to roundabout and follow Billingshurst Road for 800 metres. Go right up Spear Hill to Broomers Corner junction.

7. Continue into Countryman's Lane then left into Smithers Hill Lane at Countryman Inn and over A272 towards Dragons Green. Right at George & Dragon pub then left into Breeze Lane following signs to Christ's Hospital and Horsham.

8. Ignore right turn to Southwater and reverse the first two sections of the route past Bax Castle and Boar's Head pubs to Horsham.
