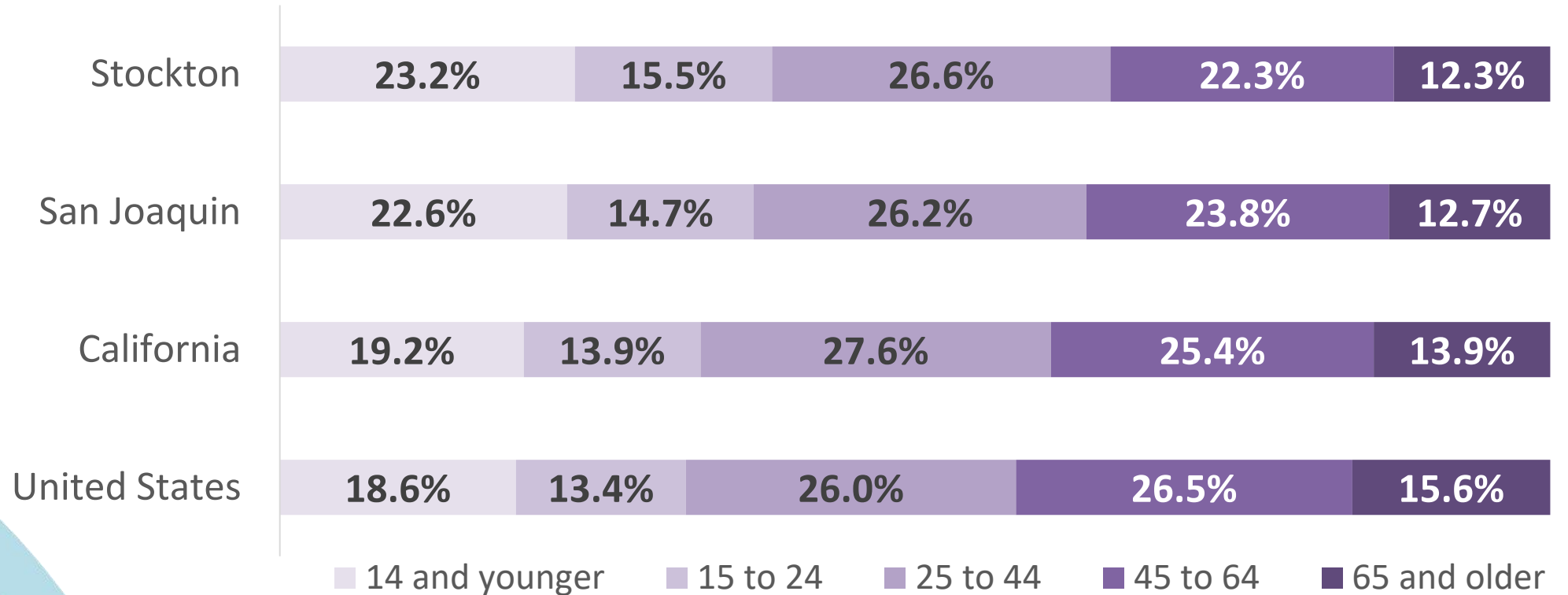

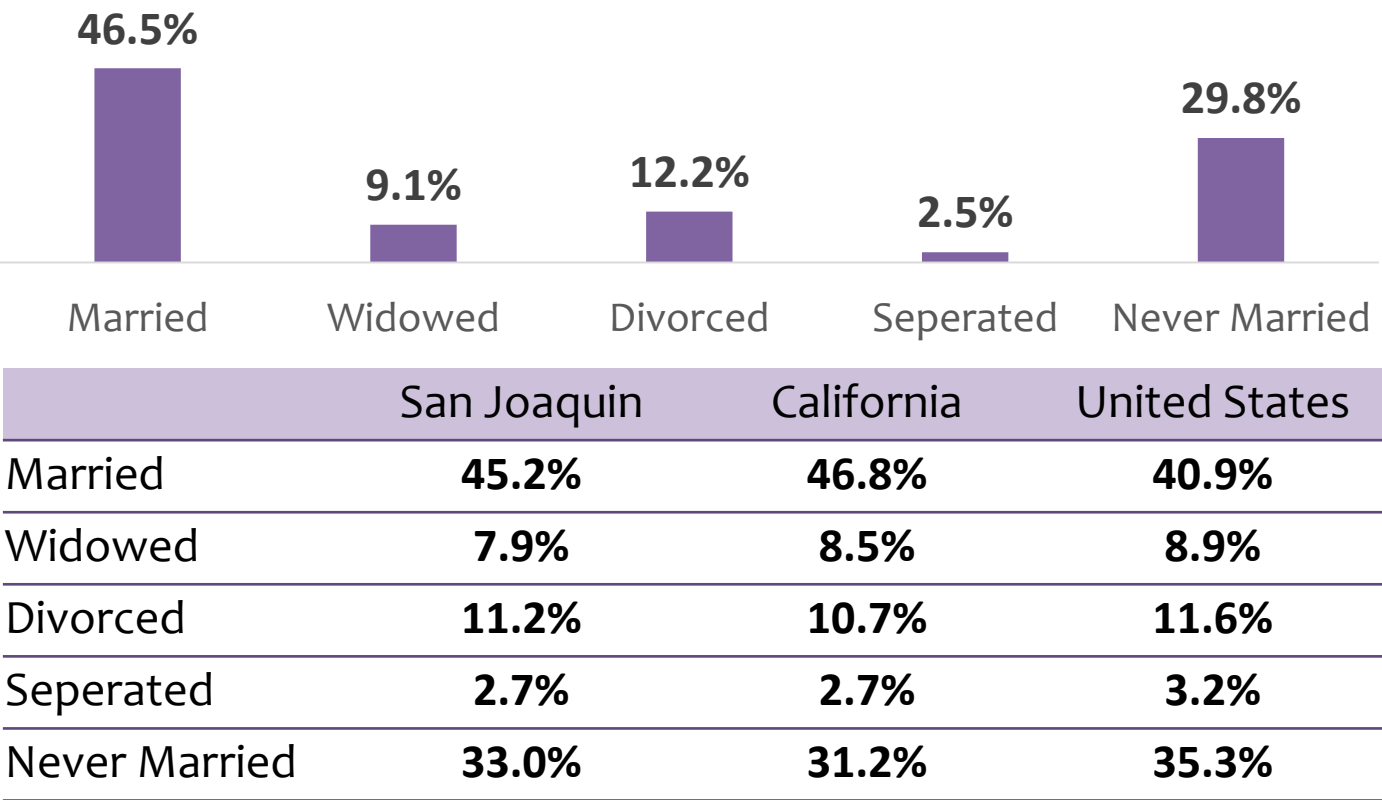

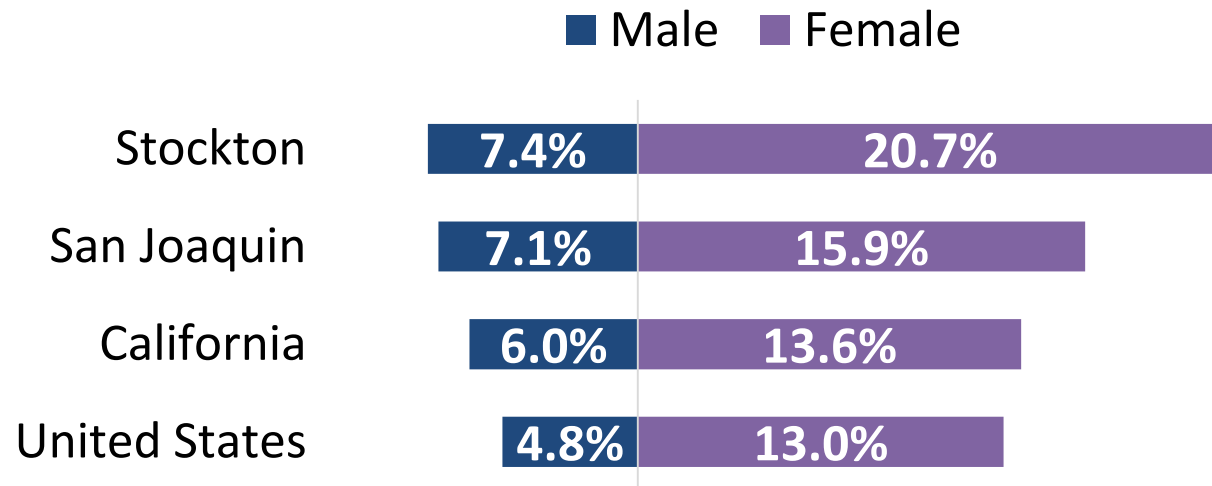
% of Women in Stockton who are Married, Widowed, Divorced, Separated, or have Never Married

## % of All Households Headed by Single Mothers



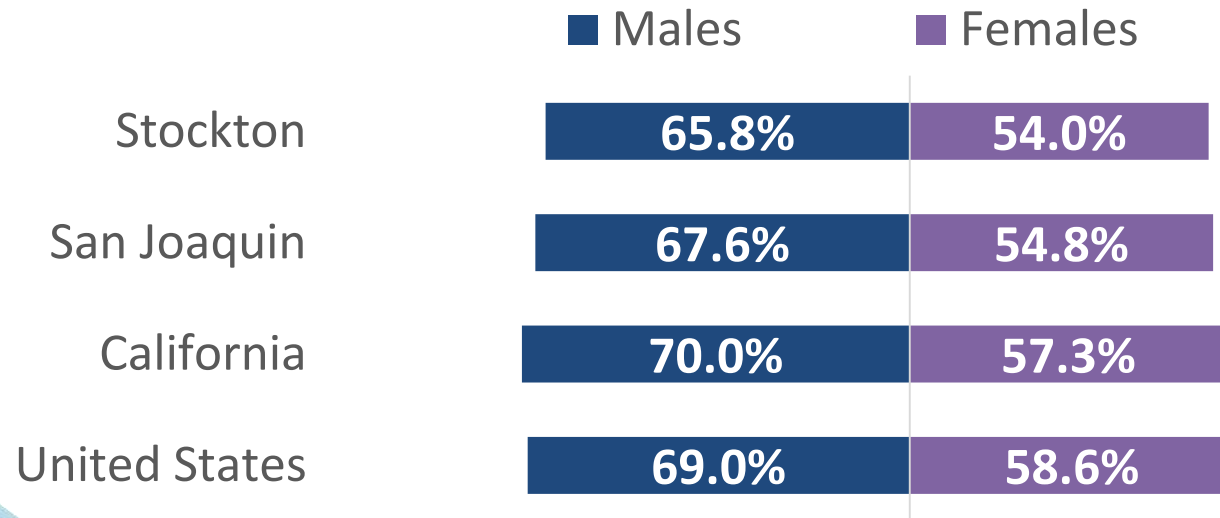

## Labor Force Participation Rate for Women Ages 16-64



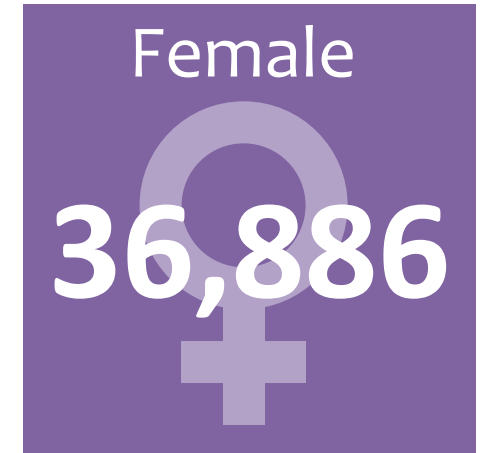

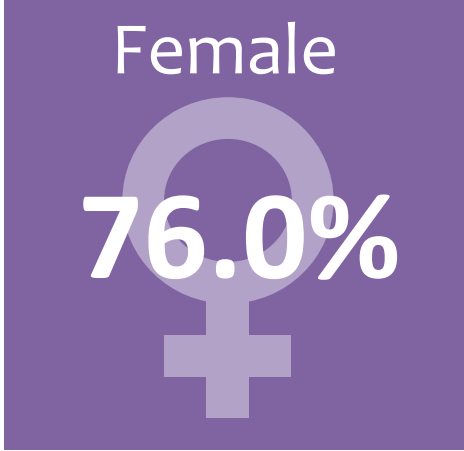

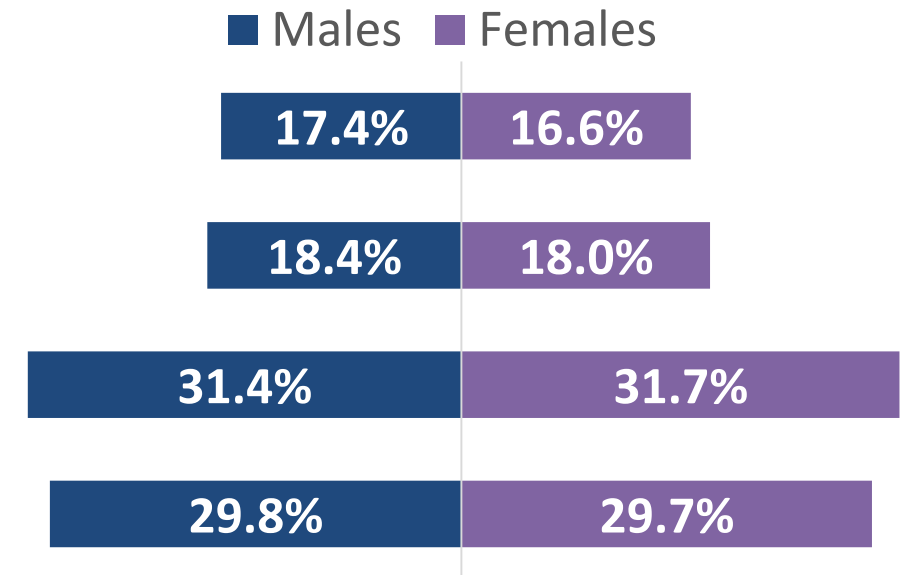

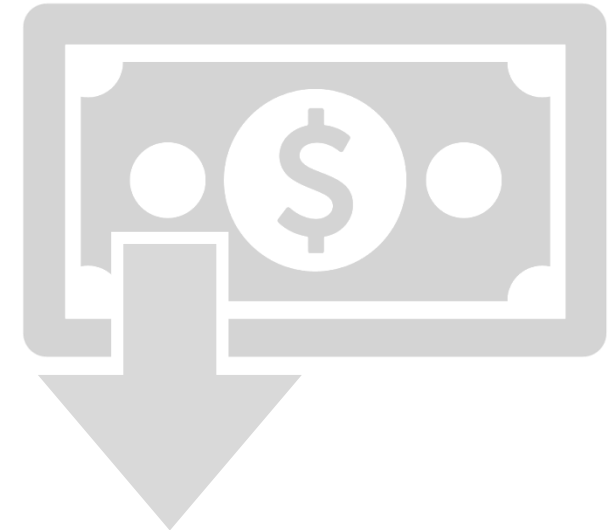

## % of Women with a Disability, All Ages

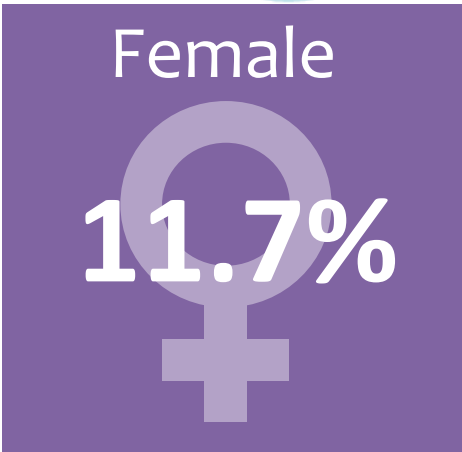
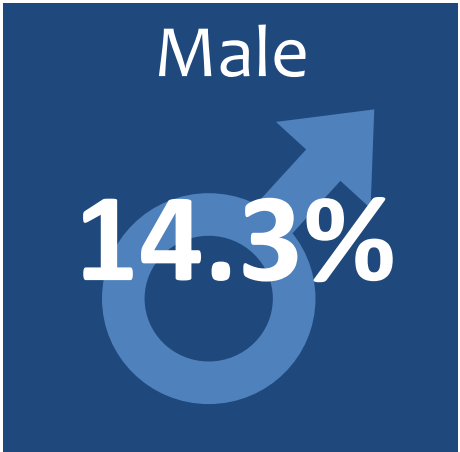

% Age 18 to 64 Without Health Insurance



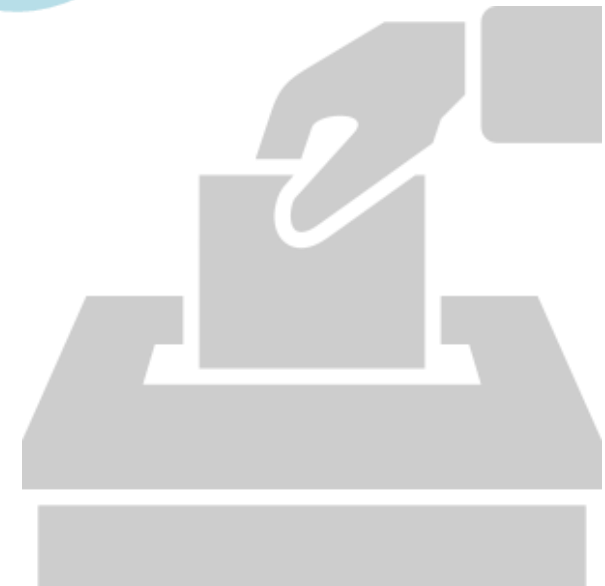
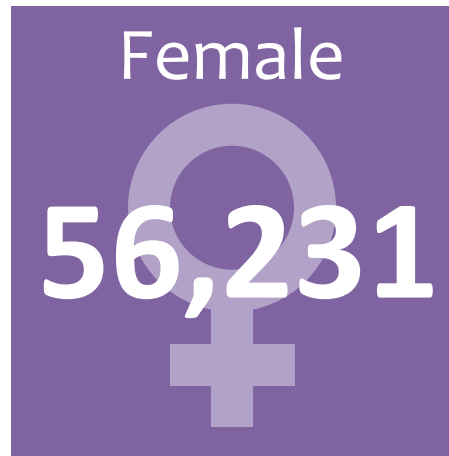
