CLUE 1

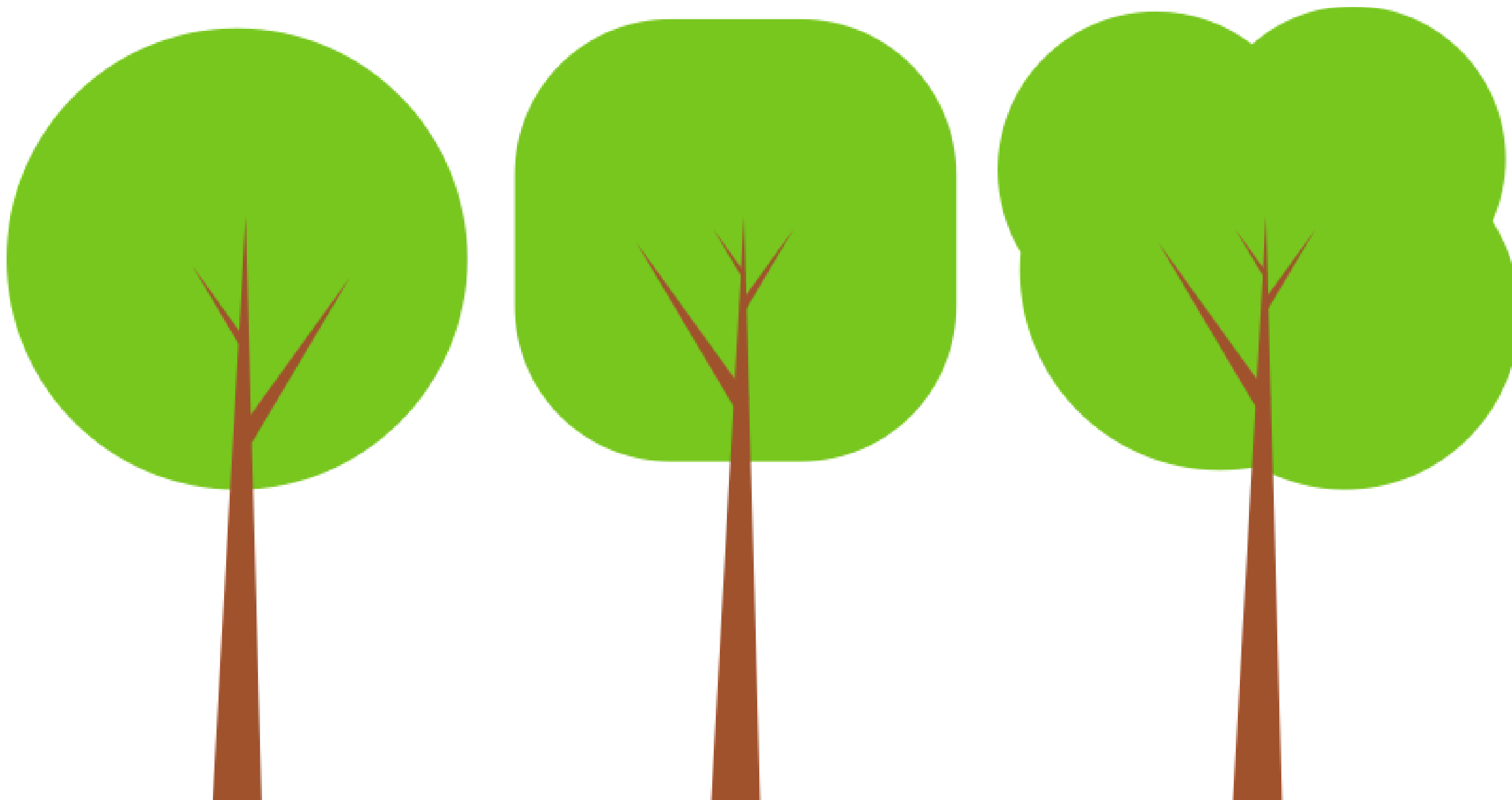
I am a special building where you can explore the final frontier. I stick out because my roof has a spherical shape. What is my name?
