## CLUE 1

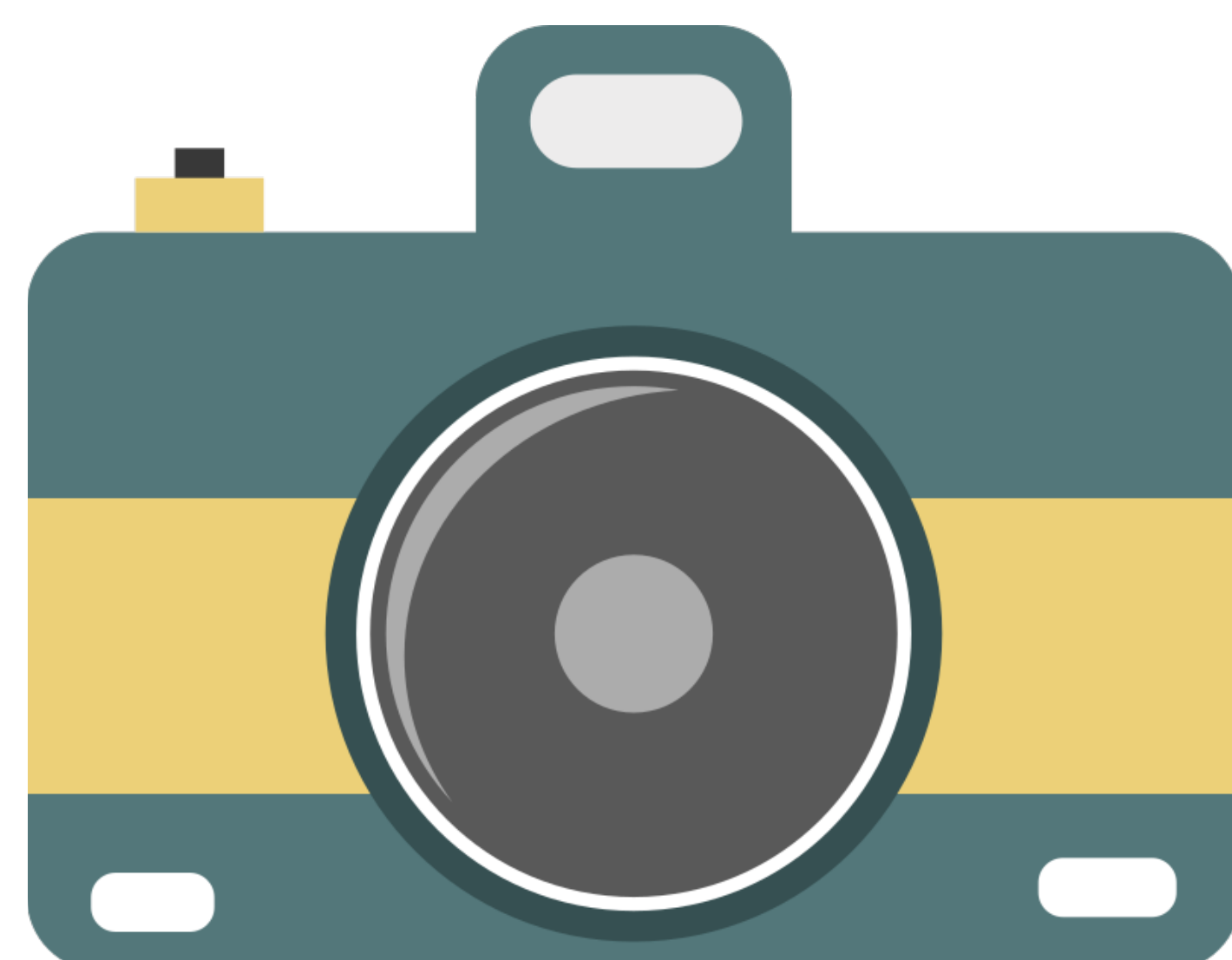
You won't find a minotaur in this entanglement. Head over to the meditation maze and take a second to relax before you begin your journey.
