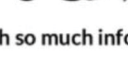

Barbara finds that the common thread for all her paintings is light and its effect on the subject. It is her goal to create, not photographic realism, but an impression of light.

Her paintings are sought after and in many notable collections throughout Alabama and other states.



Pat Weaver is an internationally recognized watercolor artist and is known for her spontaneous and vibrant work. Pat has an impressionistic approach to painting and a simplified approach to drawing. Students will explore color with a limited palette of no more than 5 colors in any one painting. Her class will be limited in size and we anticipate it filling quickly.



Stan Kurth teaches numerous workshops and shares his process around the nation and with many artist communities and organizations. We are fortunate to have Stan teaching "Freedom in Watermedia" in 2018.

Students will use a variety of techniques to implement color, line, shape and value. "The goal is a painting that is aesthetically pleasing, unique and reflective of the artists' mind."
