**Resolution of the
Tuolumne County Transportation Council**

Accepting Amendments to the following Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) between The County of Tuolumne and 2017-2019 Tuolumne County Management Association (TCMA), The 2020 Executive/Confidential Compensation Plan, and the 2017-2020 Tuolumne County Employees/OE3 as of April 16, 2020 allowing TCTC Employees to temporarily accrue 80 hours COVID 19 emergency leave.

- Whereas,** on March 27,2020 President Trump signed into law the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES, ACT); and
- Whereas,** this law amends certain provisions of the Emergency Family Medical Leave and Expansion Act (EFMLEA) and the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) which requires covered employers to provide eligible employees up to two weeks of paid sick leave at full pay, up to a specified cap, when the employee is unable to work because the employee is subject to a Federal, State, or local quarantine or isolation order related to COVID-19 ; and
- Whereas,** on April 16,2020 The Tuolumne County Board of Supervisors approved amending the current active MOU's allowing Permanent Employees to temporarily accrue 80 hours COVID-19 emergency leave as reflected in the CARES ACT; and
- Whereas,** historically the TCTC employees have been compensated consistent with the County's Employee Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs); and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Tuolumne County Transportation Council hereby approves Resolution 622-20 accepting the amendments to active Memorandums of Understandings allowing Permanent Employees to temporarily accrue 80 hours COVID-19 emergency leave as reflected in the CARES ACT.
