Resolution of the Tuolumne County Transit Agency

Adopting the Public Transit System Recommended Budget for Fiscal Year 20/21

- Whereas,** Article III, Section 1, of the Tuolumne County Transit Agency (TCTA) Joint Powers Agreement (JPA), requires the TCTA to adopt an annual budget; and
- Whereas,** the TCTA typically adopts a Final Budget in September after the close of the previous fiscal year when final expenses have been processed and more recent revenues estimates have been received; and
- Whereas,** adopting a Recommended Budget prior to July 1st will provide an operating budget in the new fiscal year until the Final Budget is adopted; and
- Whereas,** TCTA staff services are provided by the Tuolumne County Transportation Council (TCTC); and
- Whereas,** the TCTA desires to compensate a two percent (2%) COLA increase to the Assistant to the Executive Director, and the Sr. Transportation Planner position taking effect on 7/1/2020 and keeping in line with the Counties negotiated MOU's. As per Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, section 570.5 have the TCTA approve and adopt a standalone pay schedule that is to be posted and assessable to the public.; and
- Whereas,** the TCTA supports the TCTC's desire to be consistent with the County's employee reclassifications and compensations.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Tuolumne County Transit Agency hereby adopts the Public Transit System Recommended Budget for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021.
