

**Resolution of the
Tuolumne County Transportation Council**
Allocating State Transit Assistance Funds to the
Public Transportation System Budget for Tuolumne County Transit

- Whereas,** as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency for Tuolumne County, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council is responsible to consider claims against and make allocations from the Tuolumne County State Transit Assistance Fund (STAF); and
- Whereas,** the State Controller's office has provided the Tuolumne County Transportation Council (TCTC) a State Transit Assistance Fund Estimate for Fiscal Year 2017/18 in the amount of \$205,436; and
- Whereas,** pursuant to Section 99313.3, of the Transportation Development Act, State Transit Assistance Funds may be allocated for public transportation purposes only; and
- Whereas,** the City of Sonora submitted Claim No. STAF-FY18-City-1 requesting the TCTC allocate their proportionate share, equaling \$16,640, of STAF to Tuolumne County Transit services; and
- Whereas,** the County of Tuolumne submitted Claim No. STAF-FY18-CO-1 requesting the TCTC allocate their proportionate share, equaling \$188,796, of STAF to Tuolumne County Transit services; and
- Whereas,** the Tuolumne County Transportation Council has found that the above referenced City and County STAF claims are consistent with the purpose and regulations pertaining to State Transit Assistance Funds.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Tuolumne County Transportation Council approves the City of Sonora's Claim for \$16,640 and the County of Tuolumne's Claim for \$188,796 and allocates a total of \$205,436 in State Transit Assistance Fund dollars to the Fiscal Year 2017/18 Public Transportation System Budget for the costs associated with the Region's Public Transportation System.

Be It Further Resolved that this allocation is made to the appropriate purpose pursuant to Article 6.5, Section 99313.3 of the Public Utilities Code.

Be It Further Resolved that the following findings have been made by the Tuolumne County Transportation Council in accordance with Title 21, Section 6754 of the California Code of Regulations:

1. The claimant's proposed expenditures are in conformity with the Regional Transportation Plan.
2. The level of passenger fares and charges is sufficient to enable the operator or transit service claimant to meet the fare revenue requirements of Public Utilities Code Sections 99268.2, 99268.3, 99268.4, 9268.5 and 99268.9, as they may be applicable to the claimant.
3. The claimant is making full use of Federal funds available under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.
4. The sum of the claimant's allocations from the State Transit Assistance Fund and from the Local Transportation Fund do not exceed the amount the claimant is eligible to receive during the Fiscal Year.
5. Priority consideration has been given to claims to offset reductions in Federal operating assistance and the anticipated increase in the cost of fuel, to enhance existing public transportation services and to meet high priority regional, countywide or area wide public transportation needs.
