

**Resolution of the
Tuolumne County Transit Agency**

Supporting community events with special transit service for
activities held in Tuolumne County and the City of Sonora

- Whereas,** the individual communities of Tuolumne County and the City of Sonora have a diverse and active citizenry; and
- Whereas,** this active citizenry has in many cases formed charitable, non-profit and service organizations to regularly host and support events that are designed to engage and add value to the community; and
- Whereas,** Tuolumne County and the City of Sonora wish to support and encourage events that are open to the general public, hosted locally, and designed to highlight our local heritage, cultural uniqueness, history or strengthen relationships within the community; and
- Whereas,** Tuolumne County Transit provides public transportation services to Tuolumne County and the City of Sonora and has the resources to offer special transit services in support of community events; and
- Whereas,** Transit services to Special Events can improve public safety, reduce traffic congestion and parking impacts; and
- Whereas,** the provision of services will not-to-exceed \$10,000.00 per year, will not affect regularly scheduled Fixed Route or Dial-a-Ride services, and is open to the general public; and
- Whereas,** eligible applicants will be limited to Charitable, Non-profit, and Service Organizations or a Public Agency; and
- Whereas,** the TCTC will be consistent with the Transportation Development Act and the Federal Register which give direction on the provision of special transit services for charitable, non-profit and service organizations or public agencies.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Tuolumne County Transit Agency supports community wide special events with public transit vehicles taking place in Tuolumne County or the City of Sonora.
