4. Review of the 2018 State Transportation Improvement Program Fund Estimate

SB1 has provided the necessary changes in law to: 1) Re-pay past loans to the State General Fund; 2) Stabilize existing fuel taxes; and 3) Increase transportation funding through tax increases that will be phased over several years beginning in November 2017. One of the beneficiaries of SB1 is the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The STIP provides funding for both the Regional Improvement Program (RIP) (75%) and Interregional Improvement Program (25%). Each region gets a share of RIP funding based upon a formula.

The RIP share for Tuolumne County is \$6,907,000 through 2023. In the same period, the ITIP will have \$713,480,000 available statewide. With these funds, staff will present a proposed strategy to: A) Begin construction of the Peaceful Oak Interchange; B) Complete funding of the Mono Way Operational Improvement Project; and C) Initiate the SR49/108 complete street widening project through Jamestown.
