

**Resolution of the  
Tuolumne County Transportation Council**  
Allocating Fiscal Year 2019/20 Local Transportation Funds to  
Administration and Pedestrian/Bicycle Projects Reserves

**Whereas,** as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency for Tuolumne County, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council is responsible to administer the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Program for the Region; and

**Whereas,** administration of this Program includes, but is not limited to, conducting the unmet transit needs process and considering claims against and making allocations from the Local Transportation Fund; and

**Whereas,** in the adopted 2019/20 Overall Work Program, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council programmed \$199,099 in Local Transportation Funds for administration to accomplish the various work activities required of the TCTC by the Transportation Development Act; and

**Whereas,** the Tuolumne County Transportation Council desires to allocate five percent of the anticipated Local Transportation Funds each year to the Pedestrian/Bicycle Facilities LTF Reserve for future projects; and

**Whereas,** the Tuolumne County Transportation Council has found these allocations are consistent with the purpose and regulations pertaining to Local Transportation Funds.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved** that the Tuolumne County Transportation Council allocates Fiscal Year 2019/20 Local Transportation Funds to Administration and the Pedestrian/Bicycle Facilities Reserves Fund in the following amounts:

TCTC Administration Fund	199,099
Pedestrian/Bicycle Facilities Reserves	95,378
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$ 294,477</b>

**Be It Further Resolved** that this allocation is made pursuant to Article 3, Sections 99233.1, 99233.2, 99233.3 and 99400(a) of the Public Utilities Code.
