

**Resolution of the
Tuolumne County Transportation Council**
Allocating Fiscal Year 2018/19 Local Transportation Funds to
Administration and Pedestrian/Bicycle Projects Reserves

Whereas, as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency for Tuolumne County, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council is responsible to administer the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Program for the Region; and

Whereas, administration of this Program includes, but is not limited to, conducting the unmet transit needs process and considering claims against and making allocations from the Local Transportation Fund; and

Whereas, in the adopted 2018/19 Overall Work Program, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council programmed \$86,812 in Local Transportation Funds for administration to accomplish the various work activities required of the TCTC by the Transportation Development Act; and

Whereas, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council desires to allocate two percent of the anticipated Local Transportation Funds each year to the Pedestrian/Bicycle Facilities LTF Reserve for future projects; and

Whereas, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council has found these allocations are consistent with the purpose and regulations pertaining to Local Transportation Funds.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Tuolumne County Transportation Council allocates Fiscal Year 2018/19 Local Transportation Funds to Administration and the Pedestrian/Bicycle Facilities Reserves Fund in the following amounts:

TCTC Administration Fund	86,812
Pedestrian/Bicycle Facilities Reserves	38,568
Total	\$ 125,380

Be It Further Resolved that this allocation is made pursuant to Article 3, Sections 99233.1, 99233.2, 99233.3 and 99400(a) of the Public Utilities Code.
