**Resolution of the
Tuolumne County Transportation Council
Allocating RSTP Exchange Funds to
fund Railroad Crossing Improvements at two locations on Campo Seco Rd.**

- Whereas,** the Tuolumne County Transportation Council (TCTC) desires to contribute funding on a regular basis toward improvements to railroad crossings in Tuolumne County; and
- Whereas,** the Federal Transportation Act provides Federal Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) funds to the Tuolumne County Transportation Council for transportation purposes; and,
- Whereas,** pursuant to Section 182.6(g) of the Streets and Highways Code, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council annually exchanges its apportionment of Federal Regional Surface Transportation Program funds for non-Federal State Highway Account funds; and,
- Whereas,** the Sierra Northern Railroad and the County of Tuolumne have determined that two railroad crossing on Campo Seco Rd. are in need of rehabilitation and improvements; and,
- Whereas,** the Sierra Northern Railway has proposed the Campo Seco Road Railroad Crossing Improvement Project that will consist of removing the existing track structure and installing concrete tubs tieless system, at a cost of \$75,700 per crossing; and
- Whereas,** the TCTC Staff in agreement with the TAC propose to proceed with option #2 Concrete Panels over Railroad Ties, at a cost of \$60,500 per crossing; and
- Whereas,** the balance in the TCTC's RSTP Reserves Fund provides sufficient funding to cover this allocation; and
- Whereas,** this project is eligible for Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) Exchange funds; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Tuolumne County Transportation Council does hereby allocate \$121,000 in RSTP Exchange Funds Reserves to the Sierra Northern Railroad to rehabilitate and improve the two railroad crossing on Campo Seco Rd.
