Measurements:

5-1/2 x 8-1/2 – Shaded Spruce
5-1/4 x 4 (X2) – Whisper White
5-1/4 x 2 – Whisper white (to tear)
4-3/4 x 4 – Shaded Spruce (to cut out trees)

Cardstock:

Shaded Spruce (146981)
Whisper White (100730)
Medium Whisper White Envelopes (107301)

Ingredients:

Stamps: Winter Woods (147661)
Inks: Shaded Spruce (147088); Crumb Cake (147116); Cherry Cobbler (147083); Soft Suede (147115)
Big Shot (143263)
In The Woods Framelits Dies (147919)
Snail (104332)
Mini Dimensionals (144108)
Glue Dots (103683)

Directions:

1. Fold base card.
2. Run the tree outline and tree branches framelits through the Big Shot to cut out two trees.
3. Using a bone folder, stylus, or your fingers, curl the tree limbs out away from three.
4. Adhere tree with curled branches to tree base with mini dimensionals and set aside

5. On white card for inside of card, stamp in corner two pine branches and one pine cone using Shaded Spruce and Soft Suede. Adhere to inside of base card.
6. Stamp tree forest images onto the other white card with Crumb Cake stamping directly on the white card, then shifting the stamp to stamp a second image without reinking.
7. Stamp the Pine Tree stamp with Shaded Spruce over the branches. Adhere to base card.
8. Tear the smaller white cardstock slightly from the top to give the illusion of snow.
9. Stamp sentiment onto the torn cardstock with Cherry Cobbler.
10. Adhere with snail to the base card bottom.
11. Adhere the Pine Tree cutout to base card with snail.
12. Don't forget to stamp something cute on the envelope!
